### **CDL ROUTE/DELIVERY DRIVER**

The **CDL Route/Delivery Driver** provides support in the day-to-day operations and is responsible for the pick-up and delivery of product as needed. The Route/Delivery Driver works with operations managers in all aspects of deliveries. This includes the pick-up on retail routes and other donor routes as well as assists in the delivery of product to agencies, schools, and Regional Food Centers (RFC); stage orders for dock loading truck delivery; assist in the safe and orderly storage of product within the warehouse; load and unload route and transport vehicles; sort food and become proficient in Feeding America (FA) salvage guidelines; practice good warehousing as outlined in the FA manual; assist in pulling orders correctly, promptly, and in good condition for all agencies as needed; keep vehicle, warehouse, and grounds clean and neat; assist in opening and closing warehouse each day; be responsible for upkeep of LCFB vehicles to ensure they are kept in service and report damages in a timely manner.

The ideal candidate will possess a high school diploma or equivalent along with a current CDL Class A license; must be able to provide a current ten-year Motor Vehicle Record with no moving violations in the past three years; and pass a DOT physical. Have a minimum of two to five years of experience driving tractor trailers and box trucks, and working in a distribution or warehouse environment. Food safety knowledge is a plus. The candidate must be able to lift or carry items weighing 35-45 pounds, and move objects up to 1000 pounds with the proper equipment and have the ability to safely operate all types of warehouse equipment. The candidate will work a flexible Monday through Saturday schedule of 40 hours per week, and may be required to attend special events with prior notice.

**After 60 days, LDFB offers a generous benefits package including paid medical and dental insurance premiums for our employees. We also offer a vision plan, life insurance, 11 paid holidays, 15 days of accrued paid time off, plus 401(k) with a match of up to 5% at 1 year.**
